

ENTRY EXAM IN ENGLISH AT B1 LEVEL -information for candidates for studies at TUL

General information for candidates:

- 1. In order to take the entry exam, candidates need to create an account on the WIKAMP PORT platform. The link to the instructions on how to create the account will be provided to the candidates in the Candidate's Portal.
- 2. The exam takes place online on the designated day and time. The link to the exam will also be included in the Candidate's Portal.
- 3. The exam will remain open for 4 hours on the designated day, however, the candidates will have **70 min.** to solve it.
- 4. The candidates will not receive any score immediately after the attempt. The results will be published on the TUL Admissions website, according to the admissions timetable.
- 5. In order to pass the test, the candidate has to score at least **30%** correct answers.
- 6. There is **NO** oral part to this exam.

Exam format:

Listening comprehension

- Task 1: True/False (5p.)
- Task 2: Sentence-to-sentence matching (5p.)
- Task 3: Multiple-choice (a, b, c) (5p.)

Reading comprehension

- Task 4: match headings to paragraphs (4p.)
- Task 5: match the sentence to the text (4p.)
- Task 6: multiple-choice (a, b, c, d) (4p.)
- Task 7: match sentences to gaps (5p.)

Use of English

- Task 8: multiple-choice (a, b, c) (3p.)
- Task 9: choose the word that matches a pair of sentences (5p.)
- Task 10: match the words to gaps (6p.)

Written forms comprehension

- Task 11: match the words to gaps (10p.)
