



ENTRY EXAM IN ENGLISH AT B2 LEVEL- information for candidates for studies at TUL

General information for examinees:

1. In order to take the entry exam, candidates need to create an account on the WIKAMP PORT platform. The link to the instructions on how to create the account will be provided to the candidates in the Candidate's Portal.
2. The exam takes place online on the designated day and time. The link to the exam will also be included in the Candidate's Portal.
3. The exam will remain open for 4 hours on the designated day, however, the candidates will have **80 min.** to solve it.
4. The candidates will not receive any score immediately after the attempt. The results will be published on the TUL Admissions website, according to the admissions timetable.
5. In order to pass the test, the candidate has to score at least **30%** correct answers.
6. There is **NO** oral part to this exam.

- Task 7: Multiple-choice (a, b, c, d) (8p.)
- Task 8: Word formation (5p.)
- Task 9: Transformations (5p.)

Written forms comprehension

- Task 10: Gap-filling (10p.)
